- (a) & (b): According to the information furnished by University Grants Commission (UGC), the Commission considers the proposals from various universities for granting the status of "Universities with potential for excellence". The purpose of the scheme is to develop Centres of excellence in identified areas in universities which is in keeping with the goals of Ministry of HRD. The final decision to grant the status is taken by UGC on the basis of the recommendations of an expert committee constituted for this purpose. The expert committee prepares its recommendation after examining the responses to a detailed UGC questionnaire and after a detailed presentation is made before the Committee by the universities.
- (c) to (e): So far 17 universities have been accorded the status of "Universities with potential for excellence". A statement showing the details of financial assistance provided to these 17 universities is enclosed as Annexure.
