(a) to (c) No, Sir. The targets fixed for expansion of telephone exchanges in Punjab Telecom Circle for the year 1999-2000 have been duly achieved. As a matter of fact, 367444 lines were commissioned against planned target of 332500 lines. However, the installation of 7000 lines main telephone exchange at Ropar is in advance stage of installation and likely to be commissioned by May,2000.
