THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF HUMAN RESOURCE DEVELOPMENT (PROF. RITA VERMA)

(a) to (c): Universities are Statutory autonomous bodies and they take necessary action on their own, in accordance with the procedure laid down under the University Statute/Ordinances/Regulationsto fill up the vacant teaching posts. However, the UGC has been from time to time requesting the Universities to fill up the vacancies.

No centralised data with regard to State Universities, which are established under State Acts, is maintained. A statement showing the vacant position in respect of Central Universities is annexed.
