- (a) whether the attention of the Government has been drawn to the news item captioned 'Passport Scandal in Houston Consulate' appearing in the 'Hindustan Times' dated January 21, 2002;
- (b) whether similar scandals have also been reported in other Missions at San Francisco, Chicago, New York etc.;
- (c) if so, the details in this regard including the total number of entries in respect of passports in these Missions missing;
- (d) whether any inquiry has been made by the Government in this regard;
- (e) if so, the outcome thereof; and
- (f) the steps taken or being taken by the Government to avoid such recurrence?

## **Answer**
