a) The number of passports issued by the passport offices at Hyderabad and Visakhapatnam during the year 2001-2002 are as under:

Passport Office, Hyderabad - 48,163 Passport Office, Visakhapatnam - 2,39,660

b) The fees collected by both the Passport Offices during 2001-2002 are given below:

Passport Office, Hyderabad - Rs. 1,97,10,125.00 Passport Office, Visakhapatnam - Rs. 11,30,38,125.00

c)& d)The cost of issuing passports in Andhra Pradesh are in consonance with the costs in other states and no special efforts are required to reduce the costs in that state.
