(a)to(d): Granite is a minor mineral defined under Section 3(e) of the Mines and Minerals(Development & Regulation)Act,1957, granting of mineral concession for which are governed entirely by Minor Mineral Concession Rules(MMCRs) of the State Government concerned. Extraction of granite in Orissa is already in progress. As per National Mineral Inventoryprepared by Indian Bureau of Mines(IBM), a subordinate office of the Department of Mines, as on 1.4.1995, the recoverable reserves of granite are placed at 1027.4 million cubic metre in India out of which 7.588 million cubic metre reserves are in Orissa...
