(a): The income earned from software industry, which forms the largest segment of the IT industry, during the financial year 2001-2002 is as follows:

Software Exports Rs.36,500 crores
Domestic Software Rs.11,634 crores

Total Rs.48,134 crores

This amount constitutes about 2% of the Gross Domestic Product.

- (b): As per the NASSCOM estimate, the income likelyto be earned during the first half of the current financial year 2002-2003 is Rs.40,000 crores.
- (c): The steps taken by the Government to promote the Π industry are given in the Annexure.
