(a)(b)&(c): The Government of Andhra Pradesh had sent a proposal for rain water harvesting and sanitation in schools through a Scheme called 'Integrated Water and Sanitation Project in schools of Andhra Pradesh' utilizing the Technical Cooperation (TC) funds of DFID under District Primary Education Programme (DPEP).

It was found that the project proposed by the State Government did not fall within the purview of DPEP. This has been conveyed to the State Government.
