- (a) whether the Union Government have denied permission to 76 medical and dental institutions/colleges for making admissions, as reported in `Indian Express` dated June 17, 2002;
- (b) if so, the details of such institutions/colleges State- wise; and
- (c) the reasons for denying permission to these institutions/colleges? ANSWER

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO LOK SABHA STARRED QUESTION NO. 50 FOR 17.7.2002

(a) to (c): Yes, Sir. The news item relates to non-renewal of permission in respect of Medical and Dental Colleges for admitting students during 2002-03. As per provisions of Indian Medical Council (Amendment) Act 1993 and the Dentists (Amendment) Act, 1993 and the Regulations framed thereunder, the Central Government permission is granted for starting of a Medical/DentalCollege for one year. This permission is renewed on yearly basis after verification of the achievements of annual targets in respect of creation of infrastructure facilities. In case of failure of the college authorities to meet the annual target of development of infrastructure, the annual renewal of permission is not granted. The college accordingly, cannot admit students unless they rectify the deficiencies to the satisfaction of the Professional Councils and the Government of India.

Further, this process of renewal of permission is a continuous one and the Government renews the permission as and when the recommendations of the Professional Councils are received. As on 11.6.2002, permission of 76 colleges (45 dental and 31 medical colleges) was not renewed. However, subsequently the permission of 9 dental and 4 medical colleges have been renewed till date. State-wise names of medical and dental colleges wherein permission for 2002-03 has not been renewed are annexed.

All the State Governments/Universities have been informed about the status of each college for admission during 2002-03. TheState Governments have also been advised to check from Government of India before allotting students to a medical/dental college within their jurisdiction whether permission has been renewed in respect of that particular college. The status of admission in medical and dental colleges has also been made available on this Ministry's website http://mohfw.nic.in for information of the general public which is continuously updated. The concerned professional councils have also been advised to caution public in respect of the colleges, which are eligible for admission during 2002-03.
