- (a) whether the Government have made a cut in subsidy on Urea, DAP, MOP and SSP;

- (d) whether the Ministry of Agriculture has also requested the Government to rethink over its decisions; and
- (e) if so, the decision of the Government in the matter?

(a) to (e): The prices of urea, DAP and MOP have been increased by 5% as part ofthe budgetary exercise for 2002-03. Representations have been received seeking withdrawal of hike in price of fertilizers. However, such requests were not accepted in view of the fiscal sustainability of the Government.
