(a) & (b) Admissible amount as per audited expenditure against the outstanding amount of arrears due to the State Governments, as mentioned in reply to Lok Sabha Unstarred QuestionNo. 2574 dated 20.3.2002, has already been released. In addition, all the arrear claims received from the State Governments till date have also been released to the States.
