(a): whether some of the Departments/Subordinate and Attached Offices, Public Sector and Autonomous Organisations/Corporations under his Ministry are not nominating the Liaison Officers for SCs, STs, OBCs as required under MHA OMNo. 16/17/67-Est. dated 10.4.1968 DoPT OMNo. 36022/5/76 dated 27.5.1976 for ensuring proper compliance of Government instructions in the matter of reservation for SCs, STs and OBCs;

(b): if so, the reasons for the same alongwith the names of such Offices/Organisations;

(c): if not, the total number of Organisations/Offices under his Ministry which function as `Administrative Units` dealing with establishment and staff matters; and

(d): the total number of Liaison Officers nominated for the said purpose as on date?
