- (a) whether attention of the Government has been drawn to the news-item captioned `senior bureaucrats want out of Gujarat, many go on leave` appearing in the Times of India dated May 29, 2002;
- (b) if so, the facts of the matter reported therein;
- (c) the reaction of the Government thereto; and
- (d) the remedial measures taken by the Government in this regard?

Answer

(a)to(c): Yes Sir. The matter reported in the news-item relates to posting of IAS officers of Gujarat cadre within and outside the State and grant of leave etc. to such officers. The posting of IAS officers in the State and grant of leave to them is within the purview of the State Government. However, posting of IAS officers in the Government of India ismade on deputation basis at various levels under the Central Staffing Scheme, as each State Cadre has a Central Deputation Reserve.

(d): Does not arise.
