(a) & (b): There is no Minimum Support Price for palm oil or oil palm. However, proposals for the procurement of oil palm under Market Intervention Scheme (MIS) were received from the State Governments of Andhra Pradesh and Karnataka. The proposal of Andhra Pradesh has already been approved and the scheme is in operation. The proposal of Karnataka is under consideration. No such proposals have been received either from Maharashtra or Kerala.
