Will the Minister of ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS be pleased to state:

- (a) whether the Government are aware of the large scale degradation of forests in the country due to increasing mining activities;
- (b) if so, the total forest land degraded in the country due to mining activities during the last five years, State-wise; and
- (c) the steps taken by each public and private sector mining industry/company to undertake compensatory afforestation in and around the degraded areas, State-wise?

Answer

MINISTER FOR ENVIRONMENT AND FORESTS (SHRI T.R.BAALU)

- (a) Ministry of Environment & Forests grants permission under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 only for such mining proposals which are site-specific. While granting such permission, conditions are imposed to ensure that impact of mining is minimal.
- (b) A State-wise list showing the extent of forest land, which has been diverted for mining including renewal of existing mining leases, in respect of major proposals involving diversion of more than 20 hectare forest land received for forestry clearance under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 during the last five years i.e. 1997, 1998, 1999, 2000 and 2001 is annexed.
- (c) Details of compensatory afforestation carried out by the public and private sector mining industries, in lieu of the forest land diverted for mining referred to in the Annexure is being collected and shall be laid on the Table of the House.
