(a)to(e): Development programmes/projects of North Eastern States are being funded from various sources.Besides the funds allocated by the respective State Governemnts in their State Plans, all the Central Ministries/Departments (except those specifically exempted) are to earmark at least 10% of their budget for developmental programmes in the North East. The unspent balance of the earmarked funds is pooled in to the Non-lapsable Central Pool of Resources (NLCPR)The amounts utilized for the North Eastern States and transfer to NLCPR are under reconciliation.
