(a),(b)&(c): The items included in the agenda announced for socio-economic development of North Eastern Region by the Prime Minister on 22nd January, 2000 are at various stages of implementation. They include 28 programmes/projects relating to different sectors like power, border trade, horticulture, rural infrastructure, roads and airlinks, medical education, health services, industrial training institutes, information technology and other schemes of employment generation.
