## Will the Minister of COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government have increased the postal tariff by upto $100 \%$ w.e.f. June 1, 2002;
(b) if so, the details thereof and the reasons for this abnormal increase; and
(c) the additional revenue to be mopped up as a result thereof?

## Answer

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATIONS AND INFORMATION TECHNOLOGY (DR. $\mathfrak{S}$ PASWAN)
(a) \& (b): The Government have increased the postal tariff in respect of seven postal services effective from June 1, 2002. The revised rates as also the percentage increase in rates are given in the Annexure. The estimated deficit of the Department of Posts for the year 2001-2002 is about Rs. 1543 crores. The deficit of the Department is due to continuous increase in the cost of operations which are largely manual. While fulfilling the social obligation of providing affordable postal services it is imperative to have additional revenue through revision of rates, specially for services largely used by the more affluent sections of people.
(c) The expected additional revenue due to revision of these rates is Rs. 235.67 crores per annum.
