(a) and (b):- National Airports Division and International Airports Division of Airports Authority of India (AAI) are notworking independently, except that Recruitment and Promotion (R&P) Regulations followed are separate in both the divisions as were before the merger of the two authorities in 1995. This has, however, not lowered the profits of AAI. Action is at hand to have common R&P Regulations for both divisions of AAI.
