(a) the amount of cess collected on diesel and petrol by the Union Government during the last three years and the current year;

(b) of this, the amount allocated to the State Governments for the development of rural roads during the said period, State-wise;

(c) whether the Government have received any progress report from State Governments about the development of roads and utilization of allocated funds;

(d) if so, the details thereof, State-wise;

(e) if not, the reasons therefor;

(f) the reaction of the Government thereto; and

(g) the steps taken by the Government to direct the States for timely utilization of the said funds?

Statement referred to in Reply to Lok Sabha Starred Question No.129 admitted for Answer on 23rd July, 2002 The details of the amounts collected by way of Cess on Petrol (Motor Spirit) and Diesel (High Speed Diesel) during 1999-2000, 2000-01 and 2001-02 (April-November, 2001) are annexed (Annexure-I).

2. Project proposals to the tune of Rs.7553.28 crores have, so far, been cleared under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY) and the works are in various stages of execution; 7221 of the 12867 road works taken up in the year 2000-01 have since been completed and others are expected to be completed by December 2002. The road works cleared in the year 2001-02 have commenced in most States and are also expected, by and large, to be completed during the current year. The progress of works is being regularly reviewed with the State Governments/ Union Territory Administrations in the interest of timely completion of the same.

3. A Statement showing the State-wise Allocation, Expenditure incurred and the number of road works completed so far, under the Pradhan Mantri Gram Sadak Yojana (PMGSY), is enclosed at Annexure-II.
