Will the Minister of RAILWAYS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government are aware that sub-standard and unhygienic food is supplied to passengers through railway catering service in trains, particularly in Rajdhani and Shatabdi Express trains; and

(b) if so, the steps taken by the Government to improve the quality of catering services in trains?

Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RAILWAYS (SHRI DIGVIJAY SINGH)

(a) and (b) No, Sir. However, in order to bring further improvement in standard and quality of catering services, Railway has taken various steps viz. introduction of three-piece casserole packed meal in place of thali meals, introduction of eco-friendly packaging materials, supply of curd in kullarhs, ensuring quality of mineral water, review of menu and services of Rajdhani/Shatabdi and other superfast trains. Regular inspections are carried out by divisional/zonal and Board's officials. Besides special drives are being organised from time to time. Senior railway officers conduct surprise checks/inspections to ensure improvement in catering services. Complaints received are investigated and strict action taken against the defaulters. A "Catering Monitoring Cell" has also been set up in Board's office to deal with public complaints.
