(a) The progress of North-South & East-West Corridors Programme of National Highways Authority of India as on 30th June, 2002, is as under:

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    (i) Total length (Approx) - 7300 km
    (ii) Already 4-laned - 773 km
    (iii) Under implementation - 715 km
    (iv) Contract to be awarded - 5812 km
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- (b) The total estimated cost for completing of the Project shall be Rs.29,000 crore (at 1999 prices).
- (c) The details are at Annex
- (d) The Project is targetted to be completed by December, 2007.
- (e) Nil, so far as monetary aspects are concerned. However, administrative assistance in land acquisition etc is being provided by the States.
- (f) The benefits to be achieved on completion of these projects are as under:
- (i) Savings in vehicle operating costs
- (ii) Faster, comfortable journeys
- (iii) Reduced fuel consumption
- (iv) Benefits to trade especially in movement of perishable goods
- (v) Reduced vehicles maintenance costs
