- (a) & (b): Financial assistance of Rs. 90.00 lakhs under the plan schemes of the Department has been extended to three proposals for setting up food processing industries in Jammu & Kashmir during the last three years (1997-98 to 1999- 2000). Out of these one proposal is for setting up a fruit juice concentrate unit at Srinagar and the other two are for setting up multi product line Food Processing and Training Centre (FPTC) at Udheyawala and Shalimar Campus.
