- (d) whether IOCL has now agreed to take over majority shares of MRPL; and
- (e) if so, the details of plans to settle this issue of MRPL and its ownership?

Answer

- (e) Oil and Natural Gas Corporation Ltd. (ONGCL) has shown interest in acquiring stake in MRPL which is presently under study by the Government.
