Will the Minister of CIVIL AVIATION be pleased to state:

- (a) whether there is no Indian Airlines/Alliance Air flight between Nagpur and Ahmedabad and between Nagpur and Bangalore;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) whether the Government propose to start Indian Airlines/ Alliance Air or private airlines flights on these sectors; and
- (d) if so, the details thereof?

(a),(b), (c) and (d): Yes, Sir. Indian Airlines is, at present, not in a position to airlink Nagpur with Ahmedabad and Bangalore due to capacity and commercial constraints. Airline Operators are free to operate on any sector subject to compliance with the Route Dispersal Guidelines .
