(a) the number of poor families/house holds who are homeless or are living in the slums/hutments, State-wise?

Answer

Slum development being a State subject, State Governments survey and take stock of slums in their respective States. However, the Town and Country Planning Organisation (TCPO) conducted a one time study on slums in 1995-96 and brought out a report titled `A Compendium on India Slums-1996`. According to this report the identified/estimated urban slum population of the country State-wise is as given in Annexure-I.

An attempt has been made for the first time during the Census of India, 2001 by the Registrar General of India to collect detailed data about slum areas of the country but only in cities/towns having 50,000 population or more based on 1991 census. As per the provisional figures of Census of India, 2001 the slum population of States/Union Territories is given as Annexure-II.
