## Will the Minister of HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE be pleased to state:

- (a) whether breast cancer is on the increase globally and nationally;
- (b) if so, the reasons therefor;
- (c) the assistance provided to States for prevention of Breast Cancer during the last three years and till date, State-wise;
- (d) whether any NGO for women has been involved in this work;
- (e) if so, the name of such NGOs, State-wise;
- (f) whether the Government have seen Fact sheets brought out by Women Environment and Development Organisation, New York in September, 1997; and
- (g) if so, the steps taken by the Government to bring awareness among women about the programmes being run in this regard?

## **Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTERY OF HEALTH AND FAMILY WELFARE (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SH SHANMUGAM)

(a) to (g) The ICMR has reported that breast cancer is the commonest cancer among women in the world. In India the breast cancer is the second commonest cancer among women, the most common cancer is that of cervix. No reliable nation wide date on occurance of Breast Cancer is available. However, time bound analysis of data in the Population based Cancer Registries under ICMR at Mumbai, Bangalore and Madras have indicated a slight increase in incidence rate of breast cancer. The reason for this increase is not known. Under the National Cancer Control Programme grant- in-aid is provided for purchase of Memography equipment and assistance is also provided to voluntary organisations for creation of awareness and early detection of cancer including breast cancer. A statement showing assistance provided is annexed. The fact sheet brought out by Women's Environment and Development Organisation is not available.
