- (b) whether NISCOM launched a Website during September 2000; and
- (c) if so, the total amount incurred for the said web site and the fate of the earlier web site in detail?

- (a) : Yes Sir , however, NISCOM resigned from AHEAD, the IDRC project, in 1999, therefore, now NISCOM has no association withis website.
- (b) : Yes Sir, in pursuance of the Government of India policy whereby all Government Departments /institutions/organisations/Autonomous Bodies are expected to maintain and update their website for the use by public, NISCOM launched its website on 20.9.2000 with its own in-house effort .
- (c) : The payments made to NIC, Government of India for hosting the NISCOM website are as follows :

September 2000 to August 2001 Rs. 40,000/-September 2001 to August 2002 Rs. 53,000/-
