Will the Minister of TRIBAL AFFAIRS be pleased to state:

(a) whether the Government have any plans to discuss with some communities for rationalising their Scheduled-tribe Status;

(a) whether some communities are recognized as Scheduled Tribes in one district and not recognized in the neighbouring district as tribals;

(b) if so, the reasons therefor; and

(c) the steps proposed to consider representations relevant to this issue?

Answer

MINISTER OF TRIBAL AFFAIRS (SHRI JUAL ORAM)

(a) There is no such proposal at present.

(b) & (c) Yes, Sir . The notification of Scheduled Tribes is state-specific and sometimes, region-specific, since the characteristics of a community may vary from one region to another.

(c) The Government of India in June 1999, had said down a procedure formodification in the list of the Scheduled Tribes. All representations for revision of the list of the Scheduled Tribes are processed in accordance with this.
