- (a) Government has received 307 proposals aggregating to about 49,500 km for declaration of new National Highways from various States.
- (b) 13 proposals aggregating to length of about 2100 km have been received from the State of Orissa .

- (d) &((e) The proposal would be considered alongwith similar proposals received from other State Governments after the finalisation of the Tenth Five year Plan and availability of funds, keeping in view the revised criteria for declaration of new National Highways, traffic needs and inter-se priority.
