Answer

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF COMMERCE & INDUSTRY (DR. RAMAN SINGH)

(a): Cement industry is de-licensed and de-controlled. Initiatives taken by Government like increasing investment in infrastructure sector, promoting housing activities by providing suitable incentives and reduction of interest rate on loans, are aimed at improving performance of economy in general and construction activities in particular. Cement industry has been reacting positively to these initiatives by increasing production to meet the growing needs of the economy.

(b): Against the production target of 94 million tonnes, the cement industry achieved a production of 100.25 million tonnes in 1999-2000.
