- (a): Based on a preliminary proposal, Municipal Corporation of Delhi has short-listed M/s. Energy Development Ltd (EDL) for setting up Waste-to-Energy Plant on Build, Own & Operate basis at Ghazipur landfill site in Delhi.
- (b),(c)&(d): The project has neither been approved nor shelved as the Detailed Project Report has not been submitted by M/s EDL for examination in respect of techno-economic and environmental aspects.
