**Will the Minister of RURAL DEVELOPMENT be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of funds allocated and utilised under various Rural Development Projects in the country during each of the last three years and the current year, scheme-wise;
- (b) whether a large number of projects which were started during the last three years could not be completed till today;
- (c) if so, the details thereof alongwith the reasons therefor; and
- (d) the norms laid down for engaging any agency or authority on contract basis under these projects?

**Answer**

MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF RURAL DEVELOPMENT (SHRI SUBHASH MAHARIA)

- (a) Details of funds allocated and utilised under the Programmes/Schemes of the Ministry of Rural Development during the years 1999-2000 to 2001-2002 and the current year are given in the Statement at Annexure-I.
- (b) State-wise total number of the Projects sanctioned under the Swarnjayanti Gram Swarozgar Yojana (SGSY), Total Sanitation Campaign (TSC), the Sector Reform Project, the Integrated Wastelands Development Programme (IWDP), the Drought Prone Area Programme (DPAP) and the Desert Development Programme (DDP) during the last three years are given in the Statement at Annexure-II.
- (c) The projects under these Schemes are sanctioned for a period of three to five years. So the projects sanctioned during the last three years have not yet completed their gestation period and are at various stages of implementation.
- (d) These Projects are not to be implemented on contract basis.
