- (a) From time to time proposals are received from the outstanding sportspersons of yesteryears living in indigent conditions for financial assistance.
- (b) & (c): Yes, Sir. Under the scheme of National Welfare Fund for Sportspersons, lump-sum financial assistance upto Rs. 40,000/for medical treatment and pensions upto Rs. 2500/- per month are sanctioned to the retired sportspersons living in indigent circumstances, i.e., whose monthly income is less than Rs. 3,000/-.
