Discussions are expected to take place in respect of problems that have recently cropped up In Indo-Soviet relations due to the ongoing political and economic restructuring in the Soviet Union. These would include trade, economic defence and financial matters. The composition of the delegation would be determined once the agenda has been finalised.
