- (a) whether the Union Government are aware of the report of inferior quality of pharmaceutical exports;
- (b) if so, the steps being taken by the Union Government in this regrd;

- (d) whether Union Government will introduce quality control for drug exports; and
- (e) if so, steps proposed to be taken in this regard?

(a) to (e): Quality of exported drugs is not required to be checked separately. However, export of drugs from India has shown considerable growth and as per Directorate General of Commercial Intelligence and Statistics (DGCIS) datayear-wise increase registered in the export of Indian Drugs & Pharmaceuticals and Fine Chemicals during the last 3 years are as under:-

The Govt. of India vide Notification No. GSR 894(E) dated 11.12.2001 has amended schedule Mof the Drugs and Cosmetics Rules to upgrade the requirements of GoodManufacturing Practices to be followed by every drug manufacturer in the country.
