- (a) whether IREDA and other agencies extend financial assistance to mini-power plants;
- (b) if so, the details thereof and the number of applications cleared during each of the last two years;
- (c) the conditions under which Government gives assistance to such units;
- (d) whether the Government have not extended assistance uniformly to all deserving applicants; and
- (e) if so, the steps proposed to introduce transparency and also efficiency in the process of financing such units producing energy from non-conventional sources?

(a), (b), (c), (d) & (e): A Statement is laid on the Table of the House.

STATEMENT REFERRED TO IN REPLY TO PARTS (a), (b), (c), (d) & (e) OF LOK SABSTARRED QUESTION NO. 430 TO BI ANSWERED ON 19.12.2002 REGARDING FINANCIAL ASSISTANCE TO MINI POWER PLANTS BY IREDA BY S BRAHMANAIAH,

- (a) & (b): Yes Sir. Indian Renewable Energy Development Agency (IREDA), under the administrative control of this Ministry, extends loans to mini power plants based on wind energy, small hydro, bio-energy and solar energy. Financial Institutions and commercial banks also extend financial assistance to such projects, as per their own norms. IREDA has so far sanctioned 151 projects during 2000-01 and 116 projects during 2001-02. Sector-wise details are given in Annexure.
- (c), (d) & (e): The Government provides central financial assistance to such units in the form of capital subsidy & interest subsidy uniformly depending upon eligibility criteria of different schemes, technical feasibility and economic viability, subject to budgetary provisions.
