- (a) whether the Government have received any proposal/demand for creating mobile dispensary at Mulshi Taluka, Pune for backward and other classes for the project of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Medical Trust;

## **Answer**

- (a) to (c): Grant-in-aid was available to Voluntary Organisations/NGOs under the following schemes:-
- (i) Special Health Scheme for Rural Areas:- Financial assistance under this Scheme was provided to Voluntary Organisations/NGOs for setting up of new hospitals in rural areas. The scheme has been discontinued from the financial year 2001-02.
- (ii) Scheme for Improvement of Medical Services: Financial assistance under this scheme was available to Voluntary Organisations/NGOs running hospitals in rural areas or catering to urban slums for expansion of hospital building/purchase of equipment. This scheme has been discontinued from the current financial year 2002-03.

No proposal/demand for financial assistance for creation of mobile dispensary at Mulshi Taluka, Pune for the project of Dr. B.R. Ambedkar Medical Trust was received under the aforesaid two schemes.
