## **Answer**

## MINISTER OF DEFENCE (SHRI GEORGE FERNANDES)

- (a) & (b): The Defence Industry Sector was opened in May 2001 for participation by Indian Private Sector upto 100% equity, with Foreign Direct Investment (FDI), component of it being permissible upto 26%, both being subject to licensing permission. This includes all types of defence equipment. Detailed guidelines were issued by the Department of Industrial Policy & Promotion (DIPP) after consultation with the Ministry of Defence and Industry Associations, for consideration of applications for grant of license in January 2002.
- (c) Till date, 10 applications have been received through DIPP for manufacture of various types of defence equipment, out of which recommendation on 6 applications have been conveyed to DIPP.
