(a), (b) and (c): The action plan which has been drawn up aims at achieving export target of US\$ 60 billion (US\$ 50 billionfor software + US\$ 10 billion for hardware) by the year 2008 from a level of US\$ 2.7 billion in 1998-99. Various incentives have been given from time to time and the details in this regard are at Annexure-I. A statement is at Annexure-II giving some of the key initiatives taken by the Ministry of IT for the growth of this sector.
