**Will the Minister of AGRICULTURE be pleased to state:**

- (a) the details of the Centrally Sponsored Schemes implemented for the development of animal husbandry sectors in the country particularly in Uttar Pradesh, State-wise;
- (b) the funds released to the States including Uttar Pradesh for the purpose during the last three years, State-wise and scheme-wise;
- (c) the criteria laid down to release the funds to the States; and
- (d) the results achieved that sector during the above period?

**Answer**

THE MINISTER OF STATE IN THE MINISTRY OF AGRICULTURE (SHRI HUKUMDEO NARAYAN YADAV)

(a) to (d) : The Government is implementing number of Centrally Sponsored Schemes for the development of animal husbandry sectors in the country. Under these schemes funds are released to the States on the basis of availability of fund, past utilisation and viable proposals received from them. A statement indicating the scheme-wise release of funds to the States including Uttar Pradesh during the last three years is annexed (Annexure).
