- (a) whether the Government of Karnataka has been requesting the Union Government for revalidation of unspent amount of Rs.25 lakhs for establishment of Silvipasture Systems for increasing the Biomass under the Centrally Sponsored Scheme during the last two years;
- (b) if so, the reasons for not taking any decision on the issue; and
- (c) by when the Central Government is likely to revalidate the unspent amount?

(a)to(c): The Government of Karnataka was granted an amount of Rs.25.00 lakhs for establishment of silvipasture system for increasing bio-mass production during 2000-2001. The whole amount was revalidated in the year of 2001-2002. The State Government has furnished the fund utilization certificate for Rs.24.77241 lakhs out of Rs.25.00 lakhs in the month of July, 2002.
