- (a) whether any Small Hydel Power Projects are pending before the Government for clearance;
- (b) if so, the details thereof State-wise; and
- (c) the steps taken by the Government to tap vast potential small hydel energy across the country?

MINISTER OF STATE FOR NON-CONVENTIONALENERGY SOURCES (INDEPENDENT CHARGE) (SHRI M. KANNAPPAN) (a)& (b): The clearances for setting up of Small Hydro Powerprojects are provided by the respective State Governments. The Ministry of Non-conventional Energy Sources only provides the financial incentives applicable for such projects based on approved schemes and conditions thereof.

(c): Ministry of Non-conventional Energy Sources is providing various financial incentivesfor the development of small hydro power (SHP) projects, which includes assistancefor conducting detailed Surveys & Investigation, preparation of Detailed Project Reports, capital subsidy for demonstration projects, interest subsidy for commercial projects and support for Renovation and Modernisation of old SHP projects. These incentives are presently available for SHP projects up to 3 MW capacity.
