- (a) There are eight Public Sector Undertakings under the Ministry of Railways i.e. RITES Ltd., IRCON International LtdContainer Corporation of India Ltd., Indian Railway Finance Corporation Ltd., Konkan Railway Corporation Ltd., Mumb&Railway Vikas Corporation Ltd., Indian Railway Catering & Tourism Corporation Ltd. and Railtel Corporation of India Ltd.
- (b)&(c): Only 31 re-employed persons are working in these Undertakings including RITES Ltd. 15, IRCON International Ltd7, Konkan Railway Corporation Ltd. 6 and Mumbai Railway Vikas Corporation 3.
- (d) There are no categories of employees defined as Gazetted and Non-Gazetted in Railway Public Sector Undertakings. However, the recruitment from the open market, for Executive and Non-executive posts, is done through the Employment Exchanges and through advertisements in selected newspapers having good circulation in the various regions of the country.
