(a),(b)&(c): The Approach Paper to Tenth Five Year Plan emphasises the importance of ensuring balanced development of all States and indicates that the Tenth Plan should include a State-wise break-down of the broad developmental targets, including targets for growth rates and social development. The Government has been taking necessary steps from time to time to remove regional disparities through devolution of funds to States based on the recommendations of the Finance Commission and channelising funds under various schemes.
