- (a)&(b): No, Sir. Under various programmes of the Ministry of Non-Conventional Energy Sources (MNES) the awareness campaigns on use of biogas, improved chulhas, solar devices, etc are organised in local/regional languages in rural and urban areas of the country through Governmental and Non-Governmental organizations. MNES has provided financial support to the concerned State Nodal Agencies (SNAs) for their participation, by putting renewable energy pavilions, in the important events/trade fairs/exhibitions to be organized by the NGOs so that all displays and informations could be provided to the visitors in local/regional languages.
- (c): The Ministry has plans to encourage peoples participation through organization of exhibitions, competitions, seminars, etc for publicity and awareness campaigns on the use of renewable energy in the rural/urban and backward areas of the country during the 10th Five Year plan.
