- (d) whether the Union Government are seriously considering to introduce and expand Metro Rail network in view of huge crowds of travelling public in Delhi;
- (e) if so, the details thereof; and
- (f) the time by which the Tis-Hazari-Shahadra section will have Metro Rail?
