- (a) whether number of State Milk Federations running feed manufacturing units in the country;
- (b) if so, the details thereof alongwith the monitoring system of their activities; and
- (c) the raw material being used by these feed manufacturing plants during the last three years?

Answer

- (a): Yes, Sir.
- (b): There are 46 Cattle Feed Plants run by the Federations/Unions Viz. Andhra Pradesh -6, Assam-1, Bihar-2, Gujarat-8, Karnataka-4, Kerala-2, M.P.-2, Maharashtra-4, Orissa-1, Punjab-2, Rajasthan-4, Tamil Nadu-4, UP-2, West Bengal-2, Goa-1 and Pondicherry-1. The NDDB randomly picks up samples of raw materials and finished products from the various cattle feed plants run by the milk unions/federations and provide the feed back to these organizations after analysis.
- (c): Broken cereals (rice, wheat, bajra and barley), Cakes (Groundnut, Kardi and sunflower), Extractions (Babool, cotton-seed, sunflower, sal seed, sesame, rice bran, palm kernel, kokum, kardi and groundnut) ricebran, lime stone, maize, gluten, molasses, Salt etc.
