A large number of project proposals are submitted to Science & Society Divisionby voluntary organisations from all parts of Uttar Pradesh and only a few are recommended for support based on components of science & technology innovation and needs of the area. A set system of obtaining comments from generally five experts is followed. The proposal along with comments is examined by an Expert Committee which makes final recommendations on the merits of each proposal and the funds available. No comments have been received from Rekri in respect of any project proposal submitted to Science & Society Division by voluntary organistions. During the last three years, a total of 923 project proposals were received by the Division.
