- (a) whether the Government are aware that some State Governments have decided to continue with old syllabus in Government schemes instead of the new one;
- (b) if so, the names of States which have not introduced the new syllabus alongwith the reasons therefor; and
- (c) the policy likely to be adopted by the Government to ensure that new syllabus is introduced in future uniformly?

(a) to (c) Central Govt. does not prescribe syllabus or text books. It is for respective State Governments/Boards of School Education to take suitable decisions in respect of syllabus/text books to be used in their Schools.
